It's possibly the Rolling Stones' best known single,
with Sir Mick Jagger singing:

*“I can't get no satisfaction ... and I try... and I try...
I can't get no satisfaction ...”*

Are you like him: bored, fed up, with nothing that
gives real satisfaction, real peace? Are you always feeling
that there's got to be something more?

Well there is ... His name is JESUS!

Now don't dismiss this with a reflex reaction ... You
may have been to church as a kid, or seen other people
go to church, and seen them as no better than you. Going
to church doesn't make you a Christian, anymore than
sitting in the stands at a football match makes you a
football player!

I don't want to tell you about a religion or a church,
but about a man called Jesus, and about what he wants
to give you - for free!

As well as a life of satisfaction, there is also the
promise of eternal life.¹

You see, Jesus was sent by God to prove how much He
loves us.¹ God sent Him to die nailed to a cross on a hill
outside Jerusalem about 2000 years ago, yet He was an
innocent man, it was a “set up”.

The Bible tells us that we are all sinners² - that is, we're
separated from God because we don't accept His love -
and that what we do outside His love (sin) will result in our
death.³ However, if we *accept* God's love for us, and His
forgiveness for what we have done in our past, we can put
our trust in His son Jesus Christ as our Saviour.

You don't need to have reached rock bottom. A
prisoner wrote recently:-

*“I tried to find peace through drink and drugs, but it
wasn't there. I tried a life of crime, but ended up here, I even
tried a tin of lighter fluid, but that scared me even more. I
then looked at a book called the Bible ... That's where He
lives, that's where I found Him. He set me free”*

Jesus will set you free, and give you satisfaction and
peace in this life - and the next.
