

CHRIST IS THE ANSWER

There was once a shoemaker who, as he sat at work, came to think that when his clock pendulum swung to the left, it said:

"Forever"

and when it swung to the right it said:

"Where?".

He got up and stopped the clock! But although he had stopped the clock, he found that the question was still in his mind and he couldn't answer it.

Many people of all ages have no answer to this question and like the shoemaker, they try to silence it. But it cannot be silenced - for God has put "Eternity" in our hearts.
