HAVE YOU CLAIMED ALL YOUR RIGHTS?

It was recently reported that more than **£16 billion** in means-tested benefits and tax credits currently goes unclaimed every year!

These are not the only rights that go unclaimed; in fact, there is one right available to everybody which many people just don't even know exists! When Jesus died on the cross for the sins of the whole world, God his Father made available a right which anyone can claim: "To all who receive him, to those who believe in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."⁽¹⁾

It is remarkable that such available provision goes unclaimed year after year!

27 leading charities have called on the Government to set targets to improve take-up of welfare benefits and tax credits, highlighting the desperate need of those in poverty. Spearheaded by the Citizens Advice Bureau, they have written to the Secretary of State for Work and Pensions asking that more be done to ensure that the money earmarked for those in greatest need reaches them.

This right is not automatically given at birth or by a childhood ritual. It is only given to those who will claim it by believing in Jesus who took the punishment for all our sins. He died in our place on the cross.

This spiritual benefit is not means-tested. It doesn't matter how few or how many sins you have because "*There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.*"⁽²⁾

If you believe with all your heart that Jesus died for you, then you become his forever: "*I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no-one can snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no-one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.*"⁽³⁾
